The goal of transitional living is to provide residents with a safe and supportive environment in which to practice sobriety. Houses, like Winterberry, are designed for those early in recovery who require continued structure in order to establish themselves as independent, self-sufficient adults.

Living with others who are also focused on recovery can help you beat the odds of relapse. The coping skills developed will build a firm foundation as you develop life goals. You can also play a role in helping others new to recovery establish a solid foundation and achieve success.



ABOUT THE HOUSE

Winterberry is located in Hazard, KY. While near several town amenities, the home is nestled in an area that provides privacy.

Individual stays vary, but generally average 9 to 12 months.

The tenants who share this home:

- Pay a \$100 deposit upon admission.
- Pay rent at the beginning of each week, which includes basic utilities. Limited rental assistance based on income may be available.
- Pay for television and phone service.



WHY CHOOSE WINTERBERRY?

Winterberry provides a structured, safe, and sober living environment ideal for achieving long-term recovery.

House rules are peer-led and tenants are required to attend self-help and 12 step meetings, as well as complete daily and weekly chores.
